

FIFTY-FOURTHLY:

All those parcels or tracts of land, situate, lying and being in the twenty-fifth (25) township, in the sixth (6) range, west of the fifth (5) meridian, in the Province of Alberta, and being composed of:

Section five (5), and all those portions of the south half and north east quarter of section seven (7) of the said township, which lie generally to the south and east of the statutory road allowance separating the said lands from the Stony Indian Reserve Nos. 142, 143 and 144, as shown upon a map or plan of survey of the said township approved and confirmed at Ottawa on the seventeenth (17) day of September, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine (1929), by F. H. Peters, Surveyor General of Dominion Lands, and on file in the said Department of Lands and Forests, containing eight hundred and eighty-two and ten hundredths (882.10) acres, more or less.
