## Regulations

- Quiet hours in effect 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Please drive cautiously and obey all speed limits. Park roads are also used by pedestrians and cyclists.
- Prevent damage to trees and vegetation by keeping your vehicles on designated roads and parking areas.
- Alcohol is only permitted in registered campsites. Alcohol is not permitted on roads, trails, beaches, washrooms, day use picnic areas, and other public areas.
- For the safety of your pet, wildlife, and visitors, keep your pet on a leash at all times (max length 6' or 2 m). Please pick up after your pet.
- Pets are not permitted on beaches, swimming areas, or in public buildings.
- Campfires are only permitted in designated fire pits and stoves. Never leave your campfire unattended and make sure it is completely out before leaving your campsite.

Advance reservations are highly recommended in this popular campground. Facilities include showers, flush toilets, and sewage dumping. There is also a boat launch, playground, and seasonal concession.
